Two New Restaurants to Open on Campus Next Week

DOWNTOWN LOS ANGELES - Just in time for the fall semester, USC is adding two more restaurants.

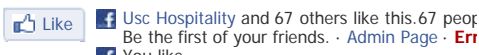
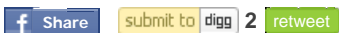
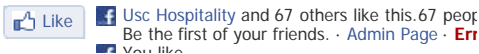
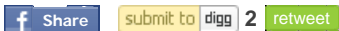
The school announced this week that Moreton Fig, an 8,000-square-foot venue with indoor and outdoor dining, lounge areas and an open kitchen, and Lemonade, the lemonade and sandwich shop, will debut at the school's Ronald Tutor Campus Center on Aug. 23.

The restaurants, located in the 192,000-square-foot, five-story hospitality complex in the center of USC's University Park campus, will be open to the public as well as students.

Moreton Fig is named after the century-old Moreton Bay fig trees that front the entrance. It will be initially open for lunch with dinner service to follow soon after the opening. The restaurant will serve burgers, sandwiches, soups, salads and more.

Lemonade will also serve lunch and dinner. The USC outpost is Lemonade's fifth Los Angeles location; it also has a spot in Downtown. The restaurant will serve sandwiches, including vegetarian items, pot roasts, desserts and, of course, lemonades.
